Greener Glenview presented its position when speaking before the Village Board of Trustees and Commissions.

- Tree Preservation Ordinance. GG Position: update needed for this 20+ year-old standard. (February, 2023)
- 2023 Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan. GG Position: use Permanent Fund money to accelerate implementation. (March, 2023)
- Valley Lo Pickleball Courts & Parking Lot Development. GG Position: reduce light and noise impacts to the West Fork. (April through September, 2023)
- Ten-Ninety Brewing Outdoor Dining & Concert Venue. GG Position: require a noise study prior to approval. (May through September, 2023)
- Dermody Phase 1 Exterior Lighting Plan. GG Position: comply with latest LEED standards. (July, 2023)
- Glenview Village Board Budget Workshops 2 and 3. GG Positions: (1) recommend monthly rather than bi-monthly meetings of the

Environment & Natural Resources Commission due to anticipated workload and (2) updated Tree Preservation Ordinance should reflect the Morton Arboretum's Gold Standard (October, 2023)

 2021 International Energy Conservation Standard. GG Position: this most recent standard should be adopted by Glenview. (November, 2023)
